



A Note on ACIFA Climate Survey Results Questionnaires are provided electronically by email

to all members of the academic staff associations

at participating institutions in November.

Results are tabulated through the

web-based Survey Monkey. The survey is based on climate surveys used by organizations involved

in total quality management programs. The literature on climate surveys suggests a strong relationship

between perceived climate and absenteeism,

turnover, and level of union activity (eg. grievances). This survey is meant to provide

a broad overview of organizational climate and highlight areas of concern for further study by administrators and faculty members. While the survey is not based on a random sample, the high rates of return provide support for the validity of the results.
